Effective immediately, The Board of Public Works of the City of Wahoo is pleased to announce the **END** of the “Boil Drinking Water’ Notice.

We regret any inconvenience caused our customers in Wahoo and Colon, but we believe the health and safety of the public is our most important responsibility.

It is regretful that a single microscopic organism was detected during one of our continuous samplings of water quality. We believe a small piece of dirt entered a broken main during repair. Normally our repair procedures preclude this contamination.

CEASE BOIL WATER

Customers of **City of Wahoo, NE3115512**, were notified on **August 17 – 18, 2011** of an E.coli bacteria contamination with our drinking water and were advised to boil water or to use bottled water.

We are pleased to report that the contamination has been corrected. Special samples have been submitted and have tested negative for total Coliform or fecal or E.coli bacteria. We apologize for any inconvenience and that you for your patience.
